Getting to Osaka Hokko Yacht Club

Nearly all train stations have a train map with colour codes. Just ask the station master. Take the JR loop line train to Nishikujo. When you arrive there take the right side exit to the street. Walk past the green stairs to the next main intersection. On your right you will see the bus stop and notice board.

There are 3 buses you can take. The 59 bus to Hokko Yacht Harbour from Umeda station or Nishikujo. It goes past a number of other stations but Nishikujo is the closest to Hokko. Alternatively, the 81 bus to Maishima Island (less frequent but handy for those staying at Amity) or the courtesy bus from/to Amity from/to Sakuraijima. You can get out at Amity and walk north to Hokko past the fabulous incinerator plant and over the big bridge. 15-20 minutes.

Enter the bus by the back door.

Pay at the front of the bus as you exit. 210yen regardless of how far you travel. When you get to the end of the line on the 59 bus, go left towards the harbour. Cross the road at the lights and you are there. You will see the Hemingway building. Melbourne House (the OHYC building) is to the left behind the containers. The Commodore will advise access arrangements.

The 81 bus will drop you and pick up at Amity to/from Nishikujo. The courtesy bus to and from Amity goes to/from the Sakuraijima station which is one stop past Universal studios on the JR Yumesaki line. You have to get on this train at Nishikujo from the JR loop line and vice versa.
